

ATTENTION SNOWMOBILERS

Snowmobile usage of the Mont Vernon Conservation Land – Purgatory Brook area

In order to ensure the enjoyment and safety of everyone to enjoy the use of these trails, the MVCC is concerned not only about the impact of this type of motorized traffic, but also sharing the trails with people who are doing passive recreation such as hiking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing.

Snowmobiles must yield to foot traffic. The following conditions and restrictions are placed on said usage of the trails.

- Half of the Class 6 road and trail must be left un-maintained for pedestrian traffic
- Contact MVCC if a large event is to take place such as fund raiser ride
- Snowmobiles are Not permitted on Sunday
- Snowmobiles Not permitted during a Storm
- Snowmobiles Not permitted between 10PM and 7AM
- Snowmobiles to stay on designated trail; except for pulling off for a break, repair, meal, but no circling allowed.
- Speed Limit of 25mph
- Trail to be marked as **a one way** entering from the Curtis Brook bridge from Lyndeborough to Class Six Dow Road onto South Wah Lum Trail to the view and out yellow gate on Purgatory Road to Upton Road heading back toward Lyndeborough.
- Yield to pedestrian traffic
- **ABSOLUTELY NO WHEELED MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALLOWED AT ANYTIME.**

These restrictions can be re-visited at any point and snowmobile use can be discontinued if rules are not followed. The MVCC has granted permission to the Wilton-Lyndeborough Wanders Snowmobile Club only, so you **must be a member of that club to use these trails**.
