Jay led a review of the 2023 financial account. Special attention was directed to the remaining unspent funds. Three options were discussed: replacement of Service flags that are flown at the War Memorial, replacement of 12 U.S. flags designated for the telephone poles, and more granite posts. Two of the three choices were selected: replacement of 12 U.S. flags designated for the telephone poles, and more granite posts. Jay motioned to spend up to \$1550.00 for the replacement of 12 U.S. flags and granite posts. The funds would be taken from line 458330 and 458320. Zoe seconded. No further discussion. All in favor.

Jay asked if Lamson Farm could store the purchased granite posts until installation in 2024. Zoe offered to contact the Lamson Farm Commission committee.

Meg shared that Wilt Stop had been purchased. Zoe and Meg will treat the row of boxwoods at the War Memorial after the meeting.

Meg shared that two purchases had been made for the Nov 11 Veterans Day reception: post card invitations and post card stamps. A balance of \$160.27 remains from the allocated \$250.00. Refreshment expenses would come from the remaining balance of \$160.27 from line 458620. Meg also shared that Zoe and she had met on Tuesday to review the refreshments and plans for Nov. 11.

Work session concluded at 1:45 pm. Jay motioned to adjourn. Meg seconded. All in favor.
