

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes April 25, 2016

7:00 pm Meeting called to order by Board Chair, Jack Esposito. Also in attendance was Selectman John Quinlan.

Board met with a resident regarding overdue taxes. No votes were taken.

7:10 pm Chief Furlong asked to go into Non Public session to address a personnel issue. Quinlan motioned, seconded by Esposito to go into Non Public session to discuss a personnel issue. All in favor.

7:30 pm Quinlan motioned, seconded by Esposito to come out of Non Public session. All in favor.
There were no votes taken.

Board reviewed the minutes of April 18th. Quinlan motioned, seconded by Esposito to accept the minutes of April 18, 2016 as written. All in favor.

Tax Collector Sue Leger came before the Board to discuss 4 abandoned trailers in the mobile home park. One is being destroyed; the other 3 are being occupied by new people that are required to fix them up to be habitable. The park wants to know what it will take to abate the back taxes on these properties. The Board is not inclined to abate the taxes on these homes, and is concerned that they may not have been properly signed over to the park. If the units are being rented out, there will be no abatements.
Board asked Brown to request that the Building Inspector assess the condition of the 3 homes and report back to them.
