Esposito: All committees / departments must be in complete agreement about the project and timing.

Cindy Raspiller, (Library Trustee): The Daland Trust is committed to working in tandem with this project.

Roberge: I would like to see some facts about meetings using the current library; what size and how many.

I struggle with the library building being used only for meeting space and Health / Welfare office. I also think you should include a rotating display of items from the Historic Society.

Quinlan: The current library may be used to house the other departments temporarily. We also discussed the Historic Society items and archives may be housed in the new library.

Chief Furlong: It does come off as we are trying to find a use for the Daland Library building.

Richard Desroches: I would like to see how much grant money is reasonable to expect to go against the total project cost.

8:35 pm End of presentation. Board moved the meeting back to the Town Hall Meeting Room.

Board reviewed and signed (6) Land Use Change Tax bills.

Zoe Fimbel came before the Board briefly to discuss the Scout project on the War Memorial lot. It seems that the Trustees have approved the money to do the site work, but are concerned about the library's leach field that is at the back of the lot. They are looking for the septic plan, which Jay Wilson has requested from the DES archives.
