

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes November 27, 2017

7:00 pm Meeting called to order by Board Chair, John Quinlan. Also in attendance were Selectmen John Esposito and Kim Roberge.

Board:

- Reviewed and signed checks and manifest.
- Reviewed and signed an application for veteran's exemption.
- Reviewed minutes of 11/20/17. Esposito motioned, seconded by Roberge to accept the minutes of November 20, 2017 as amended. All in favor.
- Reviewed a request from the Milford Select Board for a meeting regarding MACC Base Intermunicipal Agreement.

Board discussed the 8 Articles that Milford is proposing to change. Meeting with Milford at this point would be going into the meeting blind. They decided not to meet with the Milford Selectmen unless/until Milford provides their proposals on each of the 8 articles. Office will apprise Milford of this decision.

Quinlan feels that Milford wants to minimize the say we have, and maximize the money we contribute.

- Reviewed a request from Wilton Selectmen asking for the MV Board's position on the meeting request from Milford Selectmen. Office to let the Wilton Selectmen know that the only points that they are willing to discuss are: 1) Duration of the Contract and 2) Borrowing Funds.

Esposito related that our share of the SRLD budget is up \$6900 (7.5%). One of the other towns has a significant decrease and Esposito thinks there may be a mistake between the two.

Esposito asked Quinlan if he had discussed the Junk Yard Warrant Article with the Planning Board.

Quinlan said that he will do that at tomorrow's Planning Board meeting.
