Joanne explained the history of the project costs which has evolved over approximately a six year time period. *CC Warrant Article for 2019 will be 12K to finish the drainage*.

Broken, Russell Stacey, Bridge on Purgatory- Jeff checked with Wilkins Lumber to see what materials would be available and the costs. It is a big project and we will get in touch with Lyndeborough CC to see if they would be willing to coop the project with MV as this bridge is also connects with Lyndeborough.

Shelley said that she now has the new NRPC Map and has it digitized and can send to everyone.

Shelley also let us know that the owner of the three properties on purgatory brook is the original owner and she has sent him a letter to set up a time to monitor the conservation easement on these properties held by the town. No response from owner to date.
